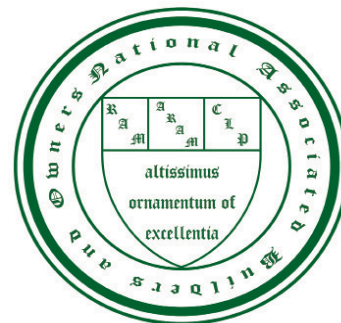

Certified Leasing Professional (CLP) is an educational and designation program offered to apartment leasing professionals by the National Associated Builders and Owners, which also sponsors the Registered in Apartment Management (RAM) designation. The CLP educational curriculum offers the essential skills and information needed to make you an effective leasing professional. The CLP designation signals to the industry that you've mastered multifamily leasing and sales skills and are a professional in the property management field.

Why Become a CLP?

Earning the CLP designation showcases your commitment to applying the best practices in leasing apartment homes. It demonstrates to your peers, clients, employers and potential employers that you have superior training and in-depth knowledge combined with practical experience. Becoming a CLP starts you on the path to gaining deeper knowledge of the property management industry, as CLP is the first step on the way to earning the prestigious Registered in Apartment Management (RAM) and Advanced RAM designations.

How long is a CLP certification valid?

CLP certification is effective for two years, subject to the payment of a \$50.00 bi-annual renewal fee. Recertification is required after that time. The recertification process requires submission of 10 hours of Continuing Education Credits: 3 hours mandatory Fair Housing and ADA/ 7 hours optional leasing topics.

Requirements
